



Program Comparison

Georgia's Home Energy Rebates are a statewide rebate program for whole home energy efficient retrofits and the purchase and installation of electric appliances. Eligible households can participate in the following programs:

Home Efficiency Rebates: This program offers rebates for multiple energy efficient upgrades throughout a home. Rebate amounts are tied to your household income and the anticipated energy savings resulting from the improvements.

Home Electrification and Appliance Rebates: This program offers rebates for qualifying households purchasing ENERGY STAR™ certified appliances, installation, insulation, and certain types of electrical work. These rebates are specifically for households earning less than 150 percent of their county's Area Median Income (AMI).

Program Incentive Amounts

80% or Greater	20-34%	Up to 50%	\$2,000
80% or Greater	Greater than 35%	Up to 50%	\$4,000
